January 5: Ford Motor Co wages jump from \$2.40/9-hr day to \$5.00/8-hr day

February 7: Charlie Chaplin debuts "The Tramp"

February 12: In Washington, DC, the first stone of the Lincoln Memorial is put into place

February 16: First airplane flight from Los Angeles to San Francisco

March 1: Harry Carey is born in St. Louis

March 14: Serbia & Turkey sign peace treaty

March 20: First international figure-skating tournament held in New Haven, Connecticut

March 27: First successful blood transfusion in Brussels

April 9: The first color film "The World, The Flesh and The Devil" is shown in London

April 22: Babe Ruth's first professional game (as a pitcher) is a 6-hit 6-0 win

May 7: US Congress establishes Mother's Day

May 8: Paramount Pictures is formed

May 21: Greyhound Bus Co. begins in Minnesota

July 14: First patent for liquid-fueled rocket design granted (Robert Goddard)

July 18: US army air service first comes into being, in Signal Corps

July 28: World War I begins

July 29: In Massachusetts, the new Cape Cod Canal opens; it shortens the trip between New York and Boston by 66 miles, but also turns Cape Cod into an island

August 5: First traffic light installed in Cleveland, Ohio



September 1: The last known passenger pigeon "Martha" dies in the Cincinnati Zoo

September 3: Pope Benedict XV succeeds Pope Pius X as the 258th Pope

September 8: HMS (formerly RMS) Oceanic, sister ship of RMS Titanic, sinks off the coast of Scotland

September 26: The United States Federal Trade Commission (FTC) is established by the Federal Trade Commission Act.

November 16: A year after being created by passage of the Federal Reserve Act of 1913, the Federal Reserve Bank of the United States officially opens for business

December 21: First feature-length silent film comedy "Tillie's Punctured Romance" is released
